# General Information

## GENERAL

The Constitution of The Nottinghamshire Golf Club and the Rules and Regulations as laid down by the Management, shall be observed at all times, copies of which are available in the Clubhouse. The Management reserves the right to refuse admission and/or cancel membership forthwith if any member shall be, in the opinion of the Management, causing a nuisance or annoyance to other members, or to other users of the club facilities.

Members, guests and visitors must abide by the dress code as laid down by the Management.

All members must report to the Golf Shop prior to play and are responsible for ensuring that their guests pay the appropriate Green Fee.

The use of Buggies and Trolleys may be curtailed from time to time during adverse weather conditions.

## ETIQUETTE

### Safety

Prior to playing a stroke or making a practice swing, the player should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or stones, pebbles, twigs etc. which may be moved by the stroke or swing.

### Consideration for other Players

The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before his opponent or fellow competitor tees his ball.

No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

In the interest of all, players should play without delay. **'Ready Golf' is encouraged when safe to do so.**

No player should play until the players in front are out of range.

If a ball is played into an area where it may be difficult to find, other than water, a provisional ball should be played from the spot where the original was played before going forward to search for the original.

**Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found. They should not search for 3 minutes before doing so. They should not continue play until the players following them have passed and are out of range.**

When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green, not mark their cards before doing so.

### Priority on the Course

In the absence of special rules, always allow faster matches to play through.

Any match losing a clear hole on the players in front, must invite the match following to pass.

### Competition Dress Code

All members who enter any club competition must adhere to the Dress Code as laid down by the Club Management.

The Committee may deem any member not complying with the Dress Code ineligible for entry to future competitions.

### Slow Play

It is the responsibility of all players to ensure that a game is played at the correct speed. The Match and Handicap Committee reserve the right in accordance with the Rules of Golf, to penalise players and or groups of players in any competition who are deemed to be holding up the pace of play.

### General Issues

All members have the right to bring any appropriate matter to the attention of the Committee. The member should raise the matter in writing to the Honorary Secretary and the matter will be dealt with by the main Committee or Officers of the Club.

### Health and Safety

In the event of lightning, which the Owner or his representative considers to be dangerous, a klaxon will sound. All players should leave the course as soon as possible. If the klaxon sounds during a competition, play is immediately suspended. Players must mark their ball and leave the course immediately – a further decision will be made by the Competition Committee as to the potential resumption of play in the competition.

## Competition Rules & Format

### 1. GOVERNMENT OF THE GAME

The Club shall abide by:

- 1.1. The Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Jan 2019.
- 1.2. The Rules and Regulations of the England Golf.
- 1.3. The Rules and Regulations of the Nottinghamshire Union of Golf Clubs.
- 1.4. The Rules of Handicapping Jan 2020
- 1.5. The Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
- 1.6. Competition eligibility rules as detailed in Section 2 will also apply. The use of Caddies **will not** be allowed during Club competitions, although an adult may escort a junior but **not** act as a Caddie.

NOTE – any golfing matter, which requires to be dealt with by means of formal Disciplinary or Grievance procedure, will be conducted in accordance with the Club Disciplinary Procedure and relevant EG guidance and procedures.

## 2. COMPETITION ELIGIBILITY

All 'Acceptable Score'(qualifying) competitions, named trophy competitions (see section 5) and knockouts in all sections of the club are subject to the following rules:

- 2.1. The club M&H Committee stipulates that a player must submit acceptable scores from a minimum of 108 holes, recorded as either General Rounds and/or in Competitions, in any combination of either 9 hole or 18 hole rounds of golf. The recording of the 108 holes of acceptable scores must be completed in the preceding 12 months immediately prior to the date of the competition. Members who have not submitted the designated number of acceptable scores may play in a competition but will not be eligible to win a prize.  
  
This will be effective from 1st January 2024
- 2.2. To enter knockout competitions, entrants must comply with the requirements in 2.1 above at the closing date for entries.
- 2.3. Members who transfer their handicap from another club may win a competition prize if their record shows that they have an established handicap index and comply with the requirements in 2.1 above.
- 2.4. Members wishing to represent the Club in external competitions should, at the discretion of the Match & Handicap Committee, be required to comply with 2.1 above.
- 2.5. All members and Members of Staff are entitled to enter Club competitions at the weekend and Bank Holidays provided they pay the entry fee and any green fee required by management. All players must have an established handicap index prior to the start of any competition, unless the competition is being used for the purposes of handicap allocation. In this instance they should not pay an entry fee and are not eligible to win a prize.

## 3. COMPETITION ENTRY & MANAGEMENT

**The ladies, seniors, juniors and mixed sections of the club may have different competition management. The following section applies to competitions run by the main committee.**

- 3.1. All competitions will be played using the appropriate handicap allowance, unless specified otherwise, and prizes will be awarded in the following playing handicap divisions.  
  
Gents - 1: 0-9 2: 10-15 3: 16-28  
Ladies- (HI). Silver: 0-20.4 Bronze 1: 20.5-27.4 Bronze 2: 27.5-54.0
- 3.2. Entry to competitions is made via the use of 'howdidido' (HDID) and in house touch screen system only, cash payments are not accepted - details of these facilities are available from any member of the committee.
- 3.3. Entry for competitions run by the main committee should be made by entering your own name and/or up to 3 other names on the relevant entry sheet via HDID or on the touch screen. Members allowing others to enter their name must take responsibility as though they had entered themselves. For major competitions a draw may be made to determine playing order within time slots
- 3.4. By entering a name, a player has shown an intent to play and failure to turn up without informing the competitions organisers WILL result in A PENALTY SCORE BEING APPLIED, as will leaving the course without good reason (and/or not reporting the fact to the committee) and failure to return a competition score on the day of competition.
- 3.5. Competitions are run on a "pre-payment" basis and the appropriate entry fee will be deducted from the player's competition account at the time of entering a name on the entry sheet, or signing in on the day

of competition. Members wishing to enter competitions should ENSURE THAT THEIR COMPETITION ACCOUNT IS KEPT TOPPED UP BY VISITING THE PRO SHOP.

- 3.6. Any member who has prepaid but withdraws formerly from a MEN'S SECTION competition prior to 23.59hrs on the day before the competition will automatically have their entry fee refunded to their competition account.
- 3.7. Any member who has prepaid but withdraws from a MEN'S SECTION competition after 23.59hrs on the day before the competition will not receive a refund and their entry fee will be included in the prize fund.
- 3.8. On the day of the competition, all competitors will be required to sign on the start sheet (in team competitions at least one member of the team must have signed the start sheet) and, if appropriate, on the computer, prior to starting play. This also applies to midweek competitions. Players are not permitted to enter the competition after they have completed their round. Specific signing in requirements may differ depending on the competition, and these will be clarified on the day.
- 3.9. In order to facilitate the closing of the competitions, players are requested to complete the top section of the score card by entering the name of the competition, the player's name and handicap index, course handicap and playing handicap with the date and start time. All players must enter their gross scores onto both the scorecard and onto the touch screen or via the HDID app on completion of the round (if appropriate).
- 3.10. In the event of a tie in stroke play competition, the winner shall be decided on count back over the final 9, 6, 3, and 1 holes of each tied fractional score in order. In the event of a tie in the MEN'S/LADIES club gross championship the winner will be decided by a 4 hole play-off. If still undecided, then a sudden death play-off will determine the winner.
- 3.11. Qualifiers for THE MEN'S AND SENIORS SECTION Medals finals are the winners of each division, and an equal scores in the division of that day, in qualifying club monthly medal competitions including the Seniors and Last Mid-Week medal of the month played since the last medals final. (Any 5 day members maybe expected to pay a green fee to play in the medals final at the weekend).
- 3.12. A Gents order of merit competition is run between May and September with designated competitions attracting points, which are accumulated and calculated into an Order of Merit table. The top 4 players are invited to participate in an away day at a course decided by the committee.
- 3.13. Results will be published by the Match and Handicap committee as soon as possible after the conclusion of each competition, and in the event of any disputes, the decision of the Match and Handicap committee shall be final.
- 3.14. The Match and Handicap committee have agreed that individual section competition organising committees will set the competition handicap limit for each competition.
- 3.15. Results will be published by the Match and Handicap Committee as soon as possible after the conclusion of each competition, and in the event of any disputes, the decision of the Match and Handicap Committee shall be final.
- 3.16. The Match and Handicap Committee have agreed that individual section Competition Organising Committee's will set the competition handicap limit for each competition.

#### **4 MATCHPLAY KNOCKOUT COMPETITIONS**

- 4.1 The entry fee must be paid before the closing date for entries. Anyone who has not paid will not be included in the draw.
- 4.2 ALL named entrant(s) in any match shall be responsible for contacting the opposition to arrange the match, and should offer 3 "reasonable" dates, which should include at least one weekend date. Once a date has been agreed, failure to turn up on time shall result in the match being forfeited. Any difficulties concerning arrangements of a match play fixture should be brought to the attention of the competition organiser as soon as possible.



4.3 All matches will be played on the championship course unless both parties agree otherwise. All matches will be played from the relevant tee tombstone (white or red), or from the relevant tee marker if it is placed within 10yards of the tombstone.

4.4 Each round must be completed by the date indicated. In the event of any match not being completed by this date, the **OUTCOME** of the match **WILL BE DECIDED** by the competition organiser whose decision shall be final. No extensions to the competition dates will be granted **UNLESS PRIOR AGREEMENT IS REACHED WITH THE COMPETITION ORGANISER WHOSE DECISION IS FINAL**. After a pairs match date is agreed, should one team only have a single player available, the match should either proceed with the single player or should be forfeited.

4.5 Matchplay handicap allowances

MEN – MAXIMUM 28

LADIES - MAXIMUM 54

SENIORS - MAXIMUM 36

Singles - full handicap difference

Four Ball better ball - 90% difference from lowest handicap

Foursomes - 50% of combined team handicap

MIXED NOTE : - Strokes should be taken from the relevant index as per the rules of handicapping recommendation unless both parties agree otherwise. Strokes **MUST** not be taken from both indexes in the same match.

The entry fee must be paid before the closing date for entries. Anyone who has not paid will not be included in the draw.

4.6 The first named entrant(s) in any match shall be responsible for contacting the opposition to arrange the match, and should offer three 'reasonable' dates, **which should include at least one weekend date**. Once a date has been agreed, failure to turn up on time shall result in the match being forfeit. Although the first named entrant(s) have the responsibility for contacting the opposition, all players should try to make this as easy as possible. Any difficulties concerning arrangement of a match-play fixture should be brought to the attention of the competition organiser as soon as possible.

4.7 All matches will be played on the Championship Course unless both parties agree otherwise. All matches will be played from the relevant tee tombstone (White or Red) or from the relevant tee marker if it is placed within 10 yards of the tombstone.

4.8 Each round **MUST** be completed by the date indicated. In the event of any match not being completed by this date, the second named entrant(s) shall proceed to the next round after confirmation of the circumstances related to non-completion of the match by the competition organiser, whose decision shall be final. No extensions to the completion dates will be granted. After a pairs match date is agreed, should one team only have a single player available, the match should either proceed with the single player or should be forfeit.

4.9 **Matchplay Handicap Allowances**

**Singles** – full handicap difference

**Four Ball Better Ball** – 90% difference from lowest handicap.

**Foursomes** – 50% the difference between the aggregate handicaps of each side. No need for additional shot as this is a mixed pairs event - extra shots cancel each other out.

NOTE – Strokes should be taken from the relevant index as per the Rules of Handicapping recommendation unless both parties agree otherwise. Strokes **MUST** not be taken from both indexes in the same match.

NOTE: The Qualifying status of Captains Day will be determined on an annual basis depending on the format of the Competition decided by the Captain prior to the event.

## 6 HANDICAP MANAGEMENT

- 6.1 An annual review of handicap index will take place before 1st January each year. This review will follow the guidance set out in the appropriate section of rules of handicapping.
- 6.2 Any handicap appeals to be heard by 2 members of the match and handicap committee
- 6.3 6.3 THE MATCH AND HANDICAP COMMITTEE WILL BE CONDUCTING HANDICAP REVIEWS AS REQUIRED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR
- 6.4 An annual review of handicap index will take place before 1<sup>st</sup> January each year. This review will follow the guidance set out in the appropriate section of the Rules of Handicapping.
- 6.5 Any handicap appeals to be heard by 2 members of the Match and Handicap committee.

## 7 COMPETITIONS PLAYED FROM DIFFERENT TEES

- 7.1 The Rules of Handicapping makes recommendations regarding handicap adjustments when players play from different tees. The exact rules and allowances for each competition will be set out prior to entry.  
Such competitions include the following:

**Bassingfield Bowl**  
**Dream Team Cup**

## 8 JUNIOR COMPETITORS



Any junior member with a handicap index (0-28.4 for boys; 0-36.4 for girls) may enter any Club Competition relevant to their gender. In the event that the prize won by a junior member is considered to be inappropriate, an alternative prize of equivalent value will be awarded; in team competitions juniors must be accompanied by at least one Adult member. Teams containing junior members are eligible to represent the Club should they win a qualifying



competition subject to the rules of the organisers. Juniors may play in Club matches at the invitation of the Team Captain.

**NOTE: Recent Health and Safety advice has indicated that junior members may be at risk from injury as a result of carrying golf bags.**

**Neither The Nottinghamshire Members Golf Club nor the Owner accepts responsibility for any injury caused as a result of carrying golf bags.**

Accordingly, it is the advice of The Nottinghamshire Golf Club that all juniors should use a trolley.

## 9 CLUB PRIZES AND PRESENTATIONS

- 9.1 Prizes for Majors and Trophy competitions are presented at Club Presentation evenings, which will normally be held in October or November; the dates are published in the Club Fixture List, with the exception of Medals finalists who qualify for Medals Final, who will receive their respective memento on Medals Final Day. All other Prize winners will be expected to be at the presentation evening to collect their prize, or to send a representative to collect it on their behalf. The Committee at their discretion will dispose of any prizes not so collected.
- 9.2 Prizes for all other competitions run by the main committee are normally issued in the form of credit added to your club membership discount card. N.B. Only use of the card in the bar will result in a discount. You may use the card in the Pro Shop but no discount will apply.
- 9.3 Any competitions run by the various sub-sections may have different prize and presentation arrangements.

## 10 LOCAL RULES

### 10.1 Out of Bounds

A ball lying over the boundaries of the course marked by WHITE posts or lines, or hedges, fences or streams. When marked by stakes or a fence, the out of bounds line is determined by the nearest inside points of the stakes or fence posts at ground level. When defined by a line on the ground, the line itself is out of bounds. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies out of bounds.

### 10.2 Immovable Obstructions

ALL ROADS, PATHS, BRIDGES ( including bridges over hazards), and low FENCES (bordering buggy paths, teeing areas), which interfere with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, shall be deemed immovable obstructions and relief MAY be taken in accordance with RULE16 (i.e. lift and drop ball within ONE club length of the nearest point of relief IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THAT POINT BUT no nearer the hole without penalty). See below.

A ball lying on a bridge, but within the margin of the hazard, is in the hazard and must be played as it lies or dropped under penalty in accordance with RULE17

ALL STAKED TREES (including guy ropes supporting trees), and FLOWER BEDS (but Excluding course shrubberies) are areas from which relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule16. (i.e lift and drop the ball within ONE club length of the nearest point of relief IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THAT POINT BUT no nearer the hole, without penalty). See below

All internal hedges and gateposts are integral parts of the course, including the shrubbery, surrounding the 5th tee on the championship course and the area behind the 14th green on the signature course - the

ball should be played as it lies, or relief taken under the appropriate rule.

### 10.3 Drainage Furrows

Any ball coming to rest in a drainage furrow in the General Area, or if such a drainage furrow interferes with stance or swing, may, be lifted, cleaned and dropped within ONE club length of the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, without penalty.

### 10.4 Fixed Sprinkler Heads

These are immovable obstructions, and they may obtain relief from interference under Rule 16.1. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard, and is on or within two club lengths of a sprinkler head which intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole (not in a hazard or on the putting green).

### 10.5 Stone in Bunkers

These are movable obstructions and may be removed without penalty in accordance with Rule 15.

### 10.6 Overhead Cables and Poles

Any ball, which strikes an overhead cable, tower or poles and supporting lines positioned such that they interfere with play, **MUST** be re-played without penalty.

### 10.7 Ground under Repair

10.7.1. Ground enclosed by white lines or hoops and areas marked with GUR notices. Rule 16 applies.

10.7.2. Temporary greens marked by white lines are GUR from which play is prohibited

- Relief MUST be taken. Rule 16 applies

**PLEASE** Replace divots, repair pitch marks and rake bunkers

**PLEASE** Keep up with match in front, not in front of the match behind.

**PLEASE** Call the following game to drive off when you reach the 2<sup>nd</sup> green on the Championship Course and the 3<sup>rd</sup> green on the Signature Course.

### 10.10 Distance Measuring Devices

In all competitions, a player may obtain distance or direction information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a, penalty for the first breach from single or related acts: *General Penalty (2 Shots)*. Penalty for second breach unrelated to first breach: *Disqualification*.

A multi functional device, such as a smartphone or PDA, may be used as a distance-measuring device, but it must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions where doing so would be in breach of Rule 4.3.

## 10.11 Other Local Rules

In addition to the local rules detailed above, other temporary local rules are introduced from time to time – details of these rules are posted on the main members noticeboard and set out in a folder in the Clubhouse – members are advised to make themselves aware of all local rules before start of play in any competition. Clarification of any rule should be addressed with the Competition Organising Committee.
